Abstract

Abstract Submission Guidelines


1. Submission format: Only electronically submitted abstracts will be accepted.
2. Language: Abstracts must be written in English.
3. Proofreading: Authors are advised to proofread for spelling and grammar before submitting.
4. Word limit: Abstracts must not exceed 300 words.
5. Text formatting: No use of all upper-case letters.
6. Content restrictions: No graphs, tables, photographs, or slide presentations.
7. Content field: The title or author's name/institutions must not be inserted in the 'Content' field.
8. Paragraph format: Abstracts will be published as one paragraph with specific formatting for headings.
9. Confirmation email: A confirmation email with an abstract number will be sent after submission.
10. Contact information: Please contact the conference Secretariat at sbsicon2025@gmail.com if you do not receive a confirmation.
11. Originality: The material must not have been published or presented at other meetings.
12. Attendance requirement: Submission implies the presenting author will register and attend the conference in Lucknow, India to present the abstract either as an oral presentation or as an e-poster if it is accepted.
13. Committee rights: The SBSICON scientific committee can change the topic or form of presentation or reject the abstract.

3. Restoring Hope
4. Miscellaneous

Important Note:

The presenting author of an accepted abstract (oral and e-poster) must register and pay the conference registration fee by July 31st, 2025 to have his/her abstract included in the Final Programme. The deadline for changing the presenting author of an abstract through the online abstract submission system is July 31st, 2025.



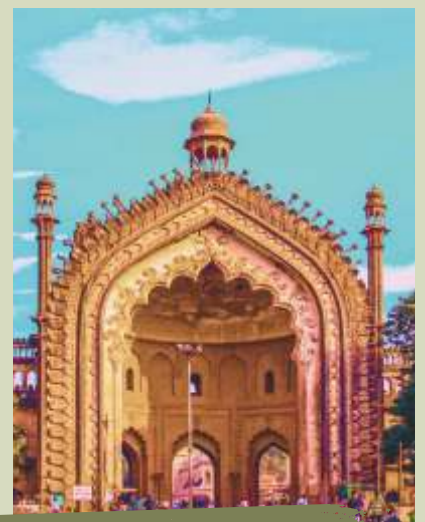
